In the following index, which covers Volume 34 - August, 2009 through July, 2010 of *Skinned Knuckles*, each subject is followed by a series of two numbers, separated by a hyphen. The first number, before the hyphen, represents the Issue Number (August is number 1, September number 2, through July number 12). The second number, after the hyphen, is the page number. In the case of a single entry, only one number will appear; in the case of multiple entries, a series of numbers, separated by a comma, will appear. Example: Coil, Ignition 4-19, 6-42, 9-27, 11-35. References to an Ignition Coil appear in issue 4 (November) on page 19, in issue 6 (January) on page 42, in issue 9 (April) on page 27, and in issue 11 (June) on page 35.
